Introducing our Big LEGO Build

Exeter Cathedral's Big LEGO Build is a 3-year fundraising project that will produce a to-scale model of the Cathedral made up of 300,000 LEGO pieces. Designed by specialist LEGO certified professionals Bright Bricks, the model will have an incredible level of detail both inside and out.

The project aims to raise over £250,000 to help preserve, conserve and share the rich heritage of Exeter Cathedral and once complete will provide an interpretation and education tool. Each brick will be sponsored through donations and donors will be given the chance to add their piece to the model.

Exeter Cathedral will aim to keep the Big LEGO Build area open from 10am-4pm daily and this is your chance to get involved and be part of this exciting project and Exeter Cathedral's history!

45+ Model Volunteers needed, including:



Model Steward - Help around the model itself by taking donations, talking with visitors and building the model.



Model Builder - The model will come in modules delivered in stages so will require a group of people to help build these behind the scenes before they go out to the public and keep a stock count of bricks.



Project Admin Assistant - Help maintain project records and files and work with the Development Office team to ensure excellent customer service and project delivery.


Why volunteer for the Big LEGO Build?
