The Proposal

FAC approval is to be sought for repairs to internal monument Number 165 dedicated to Henry Seymour that has been subject to radical change as a result of corrosion/failure of the iron fixing within. The monument is located in North Quire Aisle on the north wall of Bay 10. It is intended that the work would be carried out by the Cathedral Masons with support from Nicholas Durnan as required.

Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials) [or in the case of an object, a short description of it and details of the proposal]

It is proposed that the Cathedral Masons undertake the following works to Monument Number 165 under the supervision of the Clerk of Work and Cathedral Architect with support from Nicholas Durnan as required.

- To produce a health and safety plan for the carrying out the works including a risk assessment for handling large stone sections.
- To install temporary fencing and signage to secure an area of works.
- To carefully identify, label and record each section of marble and embedded sections associated to the monument.
- To carefully dismantle the whole monument and remove all ferrous/corroding iron fixing.
- To carefully inspect each section for damage/loss and record, remove all historic mortar/plaster before re-instatement.
- To repair the backing marble, incorporating the central fallen section (recovered from behind the monument) and repointing the fracture with a lime mortar mix coloured to match the marble.
- To carefully rebuild the sarcophagus incorporating new stainless-steel fixing sufficient to secure the monument. It is noted that plaster has been used historically to fix the local sections of marble and this should be repeated.
- To undertake local cleaning trials of the Carrara and backing marble for consultation, once approved undertake light conservation clean of monument. Note, the text should not be cleaned/repainted as this is generally legible.
