TAKE NOTICE that the Chapter of the Cathedral Church of:

applied to the Fabric Advisory Committee of the said cathedral for approval of the following proposal:

Approval is sought from the FAC for 1no new access hatch at roof level, into the roof space above the Chapel of St Gabriel.

Summary of the nature of work and its extent (and materials) [or in the case of an object, a short description of it and details of the proposal]

The cathedral uses a standard proprietary roof access hatch, several of which have been fitted to the roof of the Lady Chapel, St Andrew & Catherine's Chapel, and one will shortly be fitted to the roof of St James' Chapel. As they are considered 'tried and tested', it is proposed that another identical example be fitted to the roof of St Gabriel's chapel, allowing access into the roof void from above. This has been positioned so as to ensure there is not an excessive drop below, and to minimise the number of roof timbers which require alteration.
